We are happy to invite 4-6 young people living in Switzerland to take part in a Youth Exchange in Almuñecar full of activities around democracy and games, thus DEMOGAMES.





The Project DEMOGAMES

The project "Democracy and Games: Analog and Digital Game-Based-Learning Tools for Youth Work" (DEMOGAMES) develops educational games, methods and materials for democracy education in nonformal youth work. The project is based on the didactic, educational approach of game-based learning and applies it to teaching young citizens about democracy. *Demokrative – Initiative für politische Bildung* is one of six partner organizations of the DEMOGAMES consortium.

The Youth Exchange

Participants approach the topic of democracy in a participative and engaging manner through game-based learning techniques. Participants will play test custom-built game prototypes on different topics of democracy contribute to the further development of several democratically-themed board game prototypes themselves. These activities will be accompanied by engaging und practical inputs and workshops about learning and teaching democracy.

Objectives of the Activity

- To increase the factual knowledge and critical understanding of democratic norms, values and institutions;
- To train young people's skills within democratic processes (e.g., analytical thinking, co-operation and communication skills)
- To enable young people to reflect on their attitude towards democracy and the importance of tolerance, responsibility and respect for social inclusion in an international group;
- To develop a working understanding of game mechanics of games and their potential for educational purposes.

Participants Profile

The activity involves participants from different countries. *Demokrative – Initiative für politische Bildung* is recruiting 4-6 young adults currently living in Switzerland with the following profile:

- Aged under 30
- Residence in Switzerland
- Be interested in youth initiatives, as well as non-formal learning about, for, and through democracy in an intercultural setting
- Basic knowledge of English (at least level B1)

Travel and Accommodation

Meals and accommodation will be fully covered by the organizers. Traveling expenses will be reimbursed by the organizers – up to a maximum amount of 275 Euro – upon presentation of the travel documents and boarding pass (physical copies where possible) after the event.

Application Procedure

Please send a short CV in English (1-3 pages) and a motivation letter (max. 300 words) to office@demokrative.ch, with the subject "DEMOGAMES C2 Participant Application", by August 30th, 2021.
